What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small piece of data sent to your browser from a website you have visited. It is stored on the device you use to surf the Internet and helps the site remember information about you. For example, you place items in your shopping cart and leave the site, but when you return to the site, the items are still in your cart. Cookies make this happen. They make it easier for you to browse sites on your next visits.

What types of cookies are used on our site?

Strictly necessary cookies. They make it possible to navigate successfully. These types of cookies do not identify you as an individual. If you refuse to use this type of cookie, it may affect the performance of the website, or its components.

Performance, efficiency, and analytics cookies. These files help understand how visitors interact with the site, and they also show problems in the performance of the online resource, such as error messages. This helps to improve the performance of the site. Analytics cookies help us measure the effectiveness of our advertising campaigns and optimize the content of our sites for those who are interested in our ads. This type of cookie cannot be used to identify you. All information that is collected and analyzed is anonymous.

Functional cookies. These cookies are used to recognize users who return to our site. They allow us to tailor the content of the site to you and remember your preferences. If you block this type of cookie, it may affect the performance and functionality of the website and may limit access to content on the site.

How long do cookies stay on the device from which you access the site?

Cookies can be both session cookies and persistent cookies.

Session cookies last from the time you log in to the site until the end of that particular browsing session. When you close your browser, these cookies are automatically deleted as unnecessary.

Persistent cookies do not expire when you close your browser, but remain on your device between browsing sessions. The length of time that cookies remain on your device may vary from one cookie to another.

How do I manage cookies?

Most Internet browsers are set to accept cookies automatically. You can change your browser settings so that it blocks cookies, or warns you when these types of cookies are sent to your device. Refer to your browser's instructions for how to adjust or change its settings.
